Treatments

Treatment for All Medical Conditions Related to Infertility

For patients with fibroids, endometriosis, or polycystic ovary syndrome, Duke Fertility Center's reproductive endocrinologists will recommend the appropriate treatment to decrease pain and improve fertility. They can also help patients experience relief if they have troublesome symptoms during the hormonal transition to menopause.

Fertility Preservation

Individuals and couples may choose to freeze their embryos, eggs, or sperm in order to attempt pregnancy at a later date.

Comprehensive Stress Reduction Program

Fertility diagnosis and treatment are often emotionally draining. To address this stress, an onsite clinical psychologist provides individual and couples therapy, as well as monthly support groups to decrease the sense of isolation. Decision making consultations are available for those in need of support when considering multiple pathways or if a patient and their partner are not yet in agreement about next treatment steps.

Onco-Fertility Services

The Duke Onco-Fertility Program helps to facilitate rapid referral to fertility preservation services for cancer patients of reproductive age treated at the Duke Cancer Institute or Duke Children's Hospital and Health Center.

For emergent consults, patients will be seen within 24-48 hours. The Onco-Fertility Program has a designated patient navigator who provides patient education, assists with placing referrals/ensuring appropriate follow-up and navigating patients through the process. Resources to assist patients with reducing the financial burden of fertility preservation are also available.

LGBTQ+ Fertility Options

Starting a family is a big step in patients' lives, and Duke Fertility Center's team of fertility experts can support patients before, during, and after a pregnancy. Options are provided to create a personalized plan toward parenthood and are inclusive of individual needs, whether patients are seeking a family as a couple or individual. Reproductive endocrinologists, fertility specialists, and OBGYN providers focus on fertility treatments that are right for each unique patient. A clinical psychologist is available for emotional and social support as patients build their family.

Third Party Reproduction

For people seeking a donor, our specialists will work with them according to their preferences for an anonymous or directed donation — whether they prefer to receive eggs or sperm from someone they don't know, or have identified a donor who will be a part of their family planning.

Through Duke Fertility Center's donor egg program, individuals or couples who need a donor egg because of age or other factors can arrange to have a friend or relative be their egg donor, or apply to be matched with someone from the local area who has volunteered to be an anonymous egg donor.

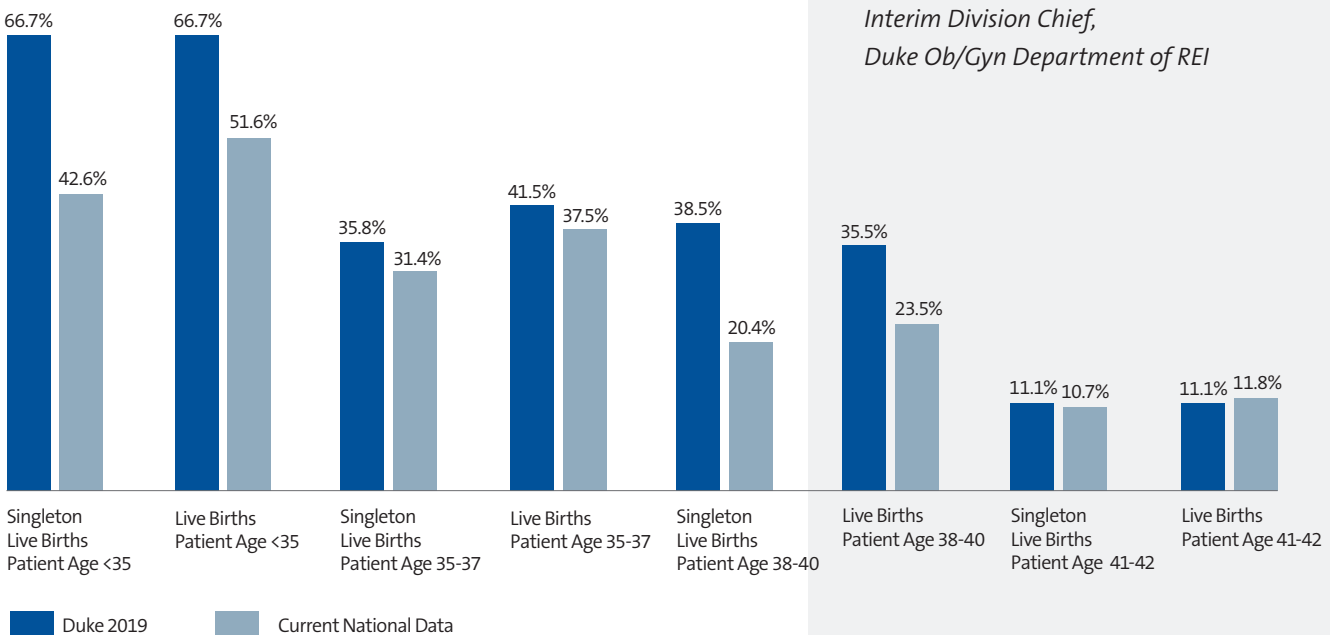
For people who want to work with a gestational carrier who delivers a child for them, Duke Fertility Center will assist with the medical and psychological screening process to verify if a gestational carrier is appropriate and well-prepared for this experience. Assistance is available to help with contacting local legal resources to handle all the appropriate legal arrangements.



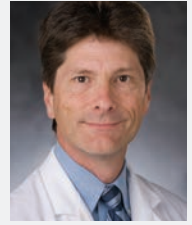
